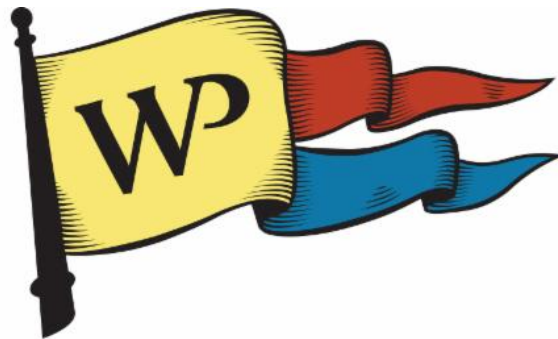


Eastern National Joins Cape Cod National Seashore for 20th Anniversary Celebration of Highland Light Move

Eastern National joins Cape Cod National Seashore for a ceremony to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the historic move of the Highland Lighthouse on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, from 2 to 4 pm at Highland Light in North Truro, Massachusetts. By the early 1990s, Highland Light sat just 100 feet from an eroding cliff edge. Thanks to a six-year effort to preserve it, the lighthouse was moved 450 feet back to safer ground in 1996.

Featured speakers will include Eastern National President and Chief Executive Officer Kevin C. Kissling and Cape Cod National Seashore Superintendent George E. Price, Jr. Additional speakers will include Massachusetts State Representative Sarah K. Peake, 4th Barnstable District; Maureen Burgess, Truro Board of Selectmen; and Mark Forest, who, as a member of Congressman Gerry E. Studds' staff, helped coordinate the federal and state efforts to fund the relocation and restoration of Highland Light and Nauset Light. Guests will also enjoy a performance by the Highland Light Scottish Pipe Band of Cape Cod.

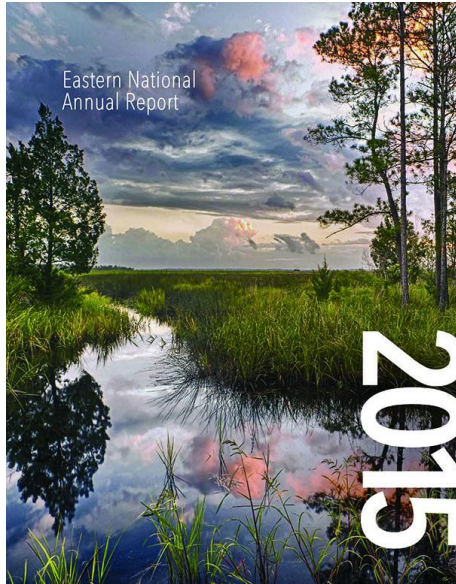
