

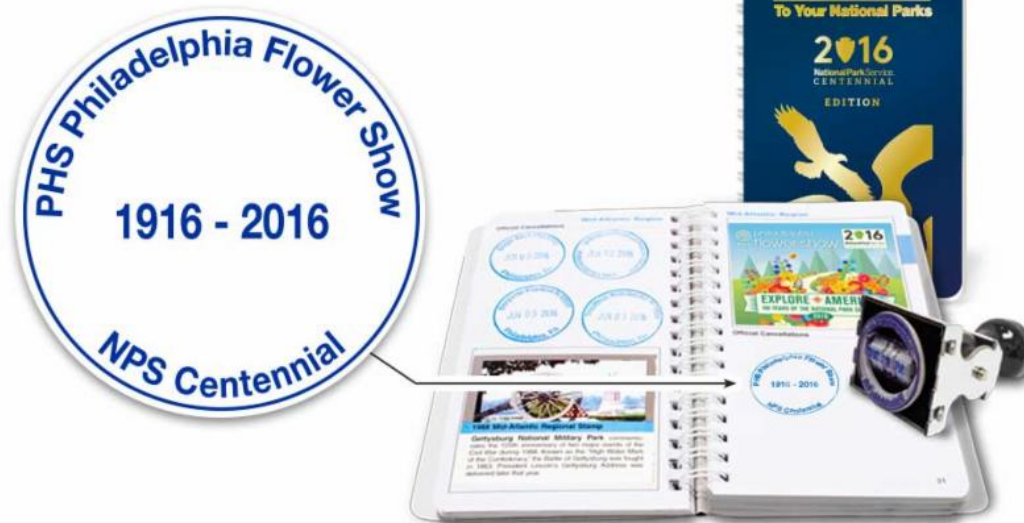

Eastern National Offers Several Exclusives at Philadelphia Flower Show

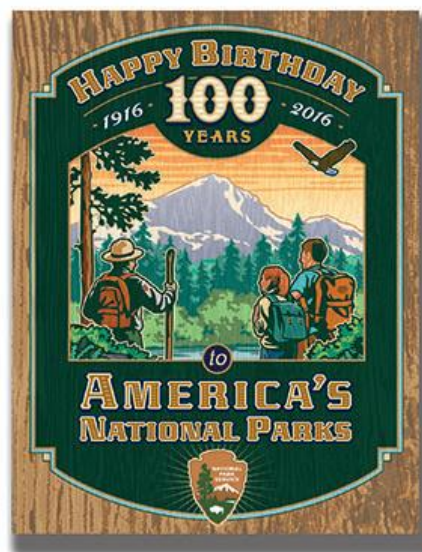
